

EFFORT GRADE CRITERIA

Effort grades run from E4 (highest) to E1 (lowest), with E2 being the norm.

Criteria:

Grade E4:

- You are always well prepared for lessons; punctual, with the appropriate books and equipment; deadlines are always met.
- You consistently demonstrate a positive approach to all aspects of your lessons.
- You co-operate fully with the class teacher, are actively engaged, participate willingly and support the learning of others.
- Your work is consistently very well presented.
- Your class work is consistently completed to a very high standard commensurate with your ability.
- Your homework is consistently completed to a very high standard commensurate with your ability.
- You respond very positively to feedback and always make an effort to act upon the advice/guidance you are given.

Grade E3:

- You are always well prepared for lessons; punctual, with the appropriate books and equipment. You rarely miss a deadline.
- You consistently demonstrate a positive approach to your lessons.
- You co-operate with the class teacher, are engaged, participate willingly and support the learning of others.
- Your work is very well presented
- Your class work is consistently completed to a good standard commensurate with your ability.
- Your homework is consistently completed to a good standard commensurate with your ability.
- You respond positively to feedback and make an effort to act upon the advice/guidance you are given.

Grade E2:

- You are generally well prepared for lessons; punctual, with the appropriate books and equipment. You rarely miss a deadline.
- You demonstrate a positive approach to your lessons.
- You co-operate with the class teacher, are generally engaged, participate and support the learning of others.
- Your work is well presented.
- Your class work is completed to a standard commensurate with your ability.
- Your homework is completed to a standard commensurate with your ability.
- You respond well to feedback and make an effort to act upon the advice/guidance you are given.

Grade E1:

- You frequently attend lessons without appropriate books or equipment. Deadlines are rarely met.
- Your approach to lessons lacks focus and interest is poor.
- You are on occasions unco-operative, can be unwilling to involve yourself and behave in a distracting manner.
- Your work is poorly presented and lacks care.
- Your class work is frequently completed to a standard which falls below our expectations and does not reflect your ability.
- Your homework is often poorly completed.
- You do not respond to feedback or take note of or act upon the advice/guidance that you are given.
